After working for two years with the Keystone Marker Trust (KMT), Arendtsville Borough Maintenance Chief Ron Cooper and Council Vice President Ferd Prehn were able to erect the traditional borough marker in early September. Ferd worked with Jack Graham of the KMT to bring this about. The end product was the placement of a replica of the original borough marker on Route 234 at the site of the new bridge over the Conewago Creek. Prehn's efforts with Graham and with KMT President Nathaniel Guest paid off with a visible marker that recently has been a rare sight in the Commonwealth.
